Student Application for Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF II)

The Federal Government recently allotted Wilson College emergency grant assistance through Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds II (HEERF II). A portion of funds will be awarded to students experiencing exceptional financial need. Funds may be used to assist with such expenses as food, housing, course material, technology, health care and childcare. Emergency grant funds may also be applied to an outstanding Wilson College account balance, at the request of the recipient.

Students must be U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens to be considered for these emergency funds. All applications will be anonymously reviewed by a committee and priority will be given to students who have not previously received emergency relief funds (HEERF II). The committee will email all applicants with the outcome of their decision. Due to funding constraints, the committee may not be able to award funds to all applicants.
