Wilson College policy is to reduce student loan amounts when students are awarded scholarships from outside agencies. Our office maintains an internal scholarship database of open and known outside scholarships and outside scholarship databases that our deposited and current students may access through their Wilson Portal. Our internal scholarship database is updated bi-weekly. Some of our students take the initiative to apply for as many scholarships as possible and have graduated from Wilson with zero loan debt.

As a student planning to attend college, now is the time to begin searching for outside scholarships. Pay special attention to the application requirements for each scholarship, such as, eligibility criteria and deadline. The following list of scholarship databases are all trusted free websites.
