To increase reliability and security on our network, we are requiring that all devices connected to our network be registered. The name of the wireless network is "WilsonCollege".

As an additional security measure, you must now enter a security key in order to connect to the network.

The key is: **wilson1869**


The key is not a secret. It will be posted at various locations on campus. It just enables us to securely encrypt the wireless data between your device and our network equipment to prevent wireless sniffing and eavesdropping.

The steps below will assist you to register your personal wireless devices on our network.

Computer/Tablet/Phone Registration:

Follow these steps to register your device:

1. Connect your device to the "WilsonCollege" wireless network.
2. Enter the Security Key when prompted: **wilson1869** (Apple devices may refer to this as a "password").
3. If a web browser does not open automatically and display the registration page, open a web browser on the device and point it to <http://packetfence.wilson.edu>
4. Click the "Public Network Access" button.




