Portfolio Requirements

All work in the Portfolio must have been completed in the last five years. CD/DVD formats are preferred and a Table of Contents document must be included. An Artist Statement/Philosophy not to exceed 250 words is also required. Links to websites are not a substitute for submitting a portfolio. Up to five additional pages of supporting materials such as published reviews will also be considered.

Choreography/Performance/Time-Based Work

Choreography or performance artists may submit up to 30 minutes of video files. For all time-based work please indicate in the title-descriptions, spaces, title, medium, duration, and date. With longer pieces, indicate any time-frame which you'd like the review committee to focus on; for example [5:34s-15:54s].

Image Portfolio

Visual artists must submit twenty (20) images. Include title, medium, dimension, and date of each image. Up to four images may be details of other objects in the portfolio.
