AAWC board of Directors Meeting  
January 25, 2015

A memorial was conducted for D'Arcy Wagonhurst who passed away in December. The Board voted to make a donation in her memorial to Friends of Peace Church.

The Executive Committee decided to change the name of Leadership Weekend to Fall Weekend (to be more inclusive).

In November, Mary and Marybeth attended the ADAPT (Alumnae Directors and Presidents Together) meeting at Cedar Crest College in Allentown, PA. It was a time to network with others and exchange ideas. We have a couple of ideas for our Association to implement this year. We hosted a reception for our alumnae/i in the Lehigh Valley during the weekend. Camilla Rawleigh joined us for this event.
