

Fulton Farm Market

We are a market-based system that allows flexibility for your purchases. You can "load" your market account and when you visit the farm stand, you choose produce according to your preferences. We subtract the total from your declining balance. Easy as that!

How does this work?

Simply set up your market account for \$50, \$100, \$250 or more. See the order form for details and incentives. We will keep your account information at the farm stand and deduct your purchase from your current balance.

What if I use my card up before the season ends?

Easy, just reload your market account at



the farm stand at anytime. Cash or checks are accepted.

Cash sales and FMNP checks are also an option at the farm stand.


