Encompass Scholarship Memorandum of Understanding

Wilson College in partnership with the National Science Foundation will offer high-achieving undergraduate students with a demonstrated financial need an annual scholarship to pursue a bachelor's degree in Biology, Biochemistry, Chemistry and/or Environmental Science.

I understand that the Encompass Scholarship has been awarded to me under the following conditions:

1. There is a demonstrated financial need, as evidenced by federal standards.
2. First-year students must have successfully graduated from one of the following Pennsylvania school districts: Chambersburg, Fairfield, Fannett-Metal, Greencastle-Antrim, Shippensburg, Tuscarora, Waynesboro or Upper Adams.
3. The amount of scholarship support will be awarded up to \$9,500.00 annually, not to exceed a total of \$38,000 across four years.
4. The duration of the scholarship is annual – September to May.
5. Participating students must maintain an overall minimum grade point average of 3.25, to be verified annually.
6. Participating students are required to be enrolled at Wilson College and classified as a full-time student within one of the following majors: Biology, Biochemistry, Chemistry and/or Environmental Science.

Wilson College limits the maximum amount of scholarship funds to the full cost of education: tuition, room and board. Any changes in enrollment (such as, but not limited to: change in major, internships, study abroad, leave of absence, temporary or permanent withdrawal) at Wilson College may impact your scholarship eligibility and must be submitted to the Wilson College Office of Financial Aid in writing.
